Stoney Lonesome Farm raises 45 varieties of vegetables, herbs and flowers for 75 families in a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program. CSA is an increasingly popular model of agriculture where local folks sign up to support a nearby farm for a season and pick up a bag of fresh produce from the farm each week. This allows people to enjoy high quality, naturally grown food, while directly supporting a farming family in your community.

Take a hayride over to Stoney Lonesome, where you will learn about organic farming and gardening methods, sample a variety of seasonal veggies, and greet some goats and work horses. You will also get a chance to learn about sustainable forestry, and even watch a team of horses pull a log from the woods. Hope to see you here!
